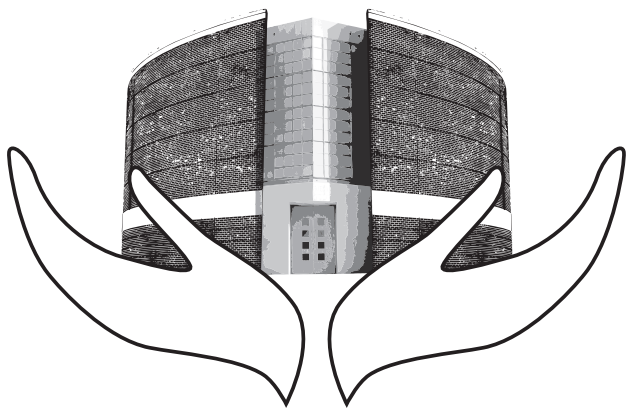


# NEED A HELPING HAND?



## FUNDS FOR FAMILIES AND VETERANS OF THE FALKLANDS WAR

The Trustees of the Falkland Islands Memorial Chapel have special funds set aside to help anyone who finds it difficult to afford the travel and/or accommodation costs involved in visiting the Chapel or in attending the Annual Service of Remembrance and Thanksgiving.

These funds are accessible only to families bereaved in the 1982 Falklands War and to veterans who served there.

## FUNDS FOR FAMILIES:

When it was disbanded in 2015, the Falkland Families Association (FFA) asked the Chapel Trustees to look after a sum of money to be used for the benefit of member families who were bereaved in 1982. More recently, former FFA committee members have asked that this fund be used to help all families to access the Chapel, irrespective of whether or not they were members of the FFA. The funds concerned are kept in a separate account which is administered by a small group of Chapel Trustees, including Sara Jones, CBE, who was the Chairman of the FFA.

The FFA fund is specifically intended to assist with travel and accommodation costs for those who would otherwise find it too expensive to travel to Pangbourne Chapel. It can also be used to provide floral tributes, made by the Chapel's Flower Guild, in memory of a loved one on a significant date or to assist with holding a special Service at the Chapel for your family and friends. If you would like to apply for assistance from this fund, please complete the application form in this leaflet and send it to the Chapel Secretary with your special request and an idea of the costs involved. Your application will be promptly considered and will be treated with the utmost confidence.

## FUNDS FOR VETERANS

The Chapel Trustees also have a separate cash fund which is available to help any veteran who is unable to access the Chapel or Chapel Service due to financial hardship or inability to travel distances unaccompanied. In these special circumstances, it may be possible for the Trustees to provide a measure of assistance, as long as funds are available for this purpose. If you would like to apply for help from this fund, please complete the application form in this leaflet and send it to the Chapel Secretary who will treat all applications with the utmost confidence.

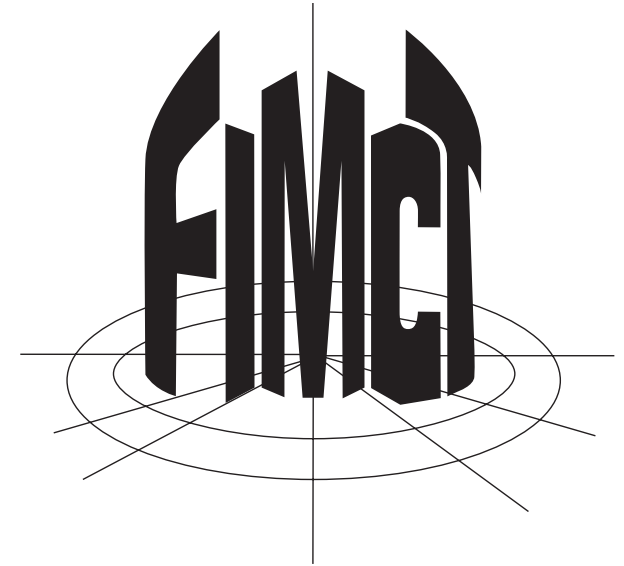
